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COMMANDER'S CORNER

A BELATED MERRY CHRISTMAS AND A HAPPY NEW YEAR TO ALL OF OUR MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES!

In our last report, our membership stood at 60% renewed for 2019. At this moment we now stand at 85% plus, and that is pretty good. We still need to get the 15% renewed for our 100% goal. In the last 11 years, we have exceeded our membership goal every year except one thanks to all the members who have supported this Post. If you have not renewed, please do so as soon as possible. Now for some really good news. Over the years, a very large percentage of our members have gotten renewal notices after they had paid their dues. This was caused by a very antiquated way of processing membership at Post level, Department level, and at National. We will now enter membership electronically directly to National. In the past, membership came to the Post, and after 3 to 4 days or a week, it was mailed to the Department of Florida. There it would be processed and forwarded to National headquarters in Indianapolis, Indiana. After they processed it, it would go across town to the membership facility. Then they would notify another company across town to discontinue membership reminders to members who had paid. This whole

process could take 1 to 2 months before being completed. Starting in January, our membership will come directly to the Post. Within 2 to 3 days we will electronically enter this information directly to National headquarters. Within a day or 2, it will be totally entered and no reminders will go out for that year. The new program will keep our members from accusing us of double billing and whatever else. No one at our Post can be any happier about this huge change than I am. I am very happy that National has finally come up with a system that will eliminate reminder notices to members who have already paid their dues. This will be a very Happy New Year!

POST 373 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Our year has not been completed, but I want to give all of the members a report on the various Legion programs that we are involved in. This year we sent 3 high school students to the Florida Highway Patrol/American Legion Cadet Program. We also sent 2 boys to Boys State. We presented school medals to 7 elementary schools and to 1 middle school. Our Auxiliary gathered miscellaneous baby items for the 5th District Final Salute (homeless female veterans and their families). We placed approximately 100 flags on veteransgraves for Memorial Day. Our Post members attend all District meetings for the Auxiliary, Legion, S.A.L., and Riders. Some of our members teach at the District Training Seminars. We also teach at the Fall Conference and at the Department Convention. Our members visit those vets in hospitals, rehab, and hospice facilities. We provide transportation for vets who need it to their doctors, shopping, and wherever they need to go. Our officers attend the Clay County Veterans meetings, and some of them are officers in this program. Our members have served in official capacity at the National Cemetery for vet services and the MIA ceremonies. We visit and evaluate veterans who need financial help, some we help with our Post funds, and if our Post cand handle it, we forward this information to The Department of Florida and then on to National headquarters. The American Legion firmly believes that no veteran and their family should go without want. Sometimes we get taken advantage of, but we cannot let a vet and their family fall through the cracks. At least now you know some of the work that your Post is doing. The Legion was started 100 years ago at the end of World War I for the purpose of assisting veterans who might need help.
