For 8 straight years we have been recognized and given awards by National and the Department of Florida. A couple months ago, we were awarded the best Post in District 5 out of 19 Posts. Like every Post, we have about 10% to 15% of our members doing all the work. Even if you never attend any of our meetings or get involved in any of our programs, <u>you are still an important member of Post 373</u>.
