First thing – I want to wish all of you and your families and friends a very Happy Thanksgiving, followed by a Merry Christmas, and a Happy New Year! You, the members of this Post, regardless if you are heavily involved or just card carrying members, you make this Post what it is. All of our successes, since we revitalized this Post back in October of 2008, are because of you. Last year our Post received "Post of the Year" for the 5th District. There are 19 Posts in the 5th District spread over Nassau, Duval, St. Johns, and Clay County. So this is quite an accomplishment. We also received a "Post Excellence" Award from National Headquarters. Only 16 Posts out of the 300+ Posts in Florida received this honor. Your Sgt. at Arms was awarded the "Best Post Level Sgt. at Arms" in the state of Florida. So you can see, even though we do not have our own Post home at this time, we must be doing things the right way.

Our Post is involved in approximately 1 dozen American Legion Programs each year. When we say "Vets Helping Vets", we mean it. We are also involved in the community working with the county commissioners to see that our veterans are recognized in Clay County. I am also the President of the Clay County Veterans Council. Matt Ruxton is the Sgt. at Arms, John Roberson is the Chaplain, and Joney Haff is the Secretary. So you can see, with a dozen different veteran organizations involved, your Post is well represented. This Veterans Council meets once a month and we work with the county administration.

We played a big part in starting Clay County Veterans Appreciation Day at the county fairgrounds. We had approximately 2,000 veterans and their families attend this event. We are also involved in Stand Downs for homeless vets and other vets and their
