#### **MEMBERSHIP**

When we revitalized this Post in 2008/2009, we started out with 73 members, of which 6 quit immediately. We were able to recruit enough members that year, which was the 2009 calendar year, to have an all-time high in membership. Every year since including 2014, we have had an all- time high. We ended the 2014 membership year with 343 members, not counting the Auxiliary. We need to maintain this growth pattern for several more years. WHY? Answer: There is strength in numbers, and with more members paying yearly dues, we are able to pay our bills and save money for our building fund. You do not have to attend meetings at our Post to belong. However, we would like to see you come to a meeting once or twice a year so you can see for yourself what good we are doing for veterans and the community. Our meetings are smoke free and alcohol free, and we conduct the meetings by the Rules of The American Legion. After the meetings we have a social time, where we get to know each other and discuss ideas about what our Post should do in the future. We have never had a single person raise their voice in anger. We are adults and act accordingly.

The National office, working with the Department of Florida, sets monthly membership renewal dates and the number of memberships required at that time. If a Post hits or exceeds these membership goals, they receive awards. We also get tickets in our Post name to go into a hopper for drawings at the Fall Conference and at the June Convention. The more tickets we acquire, the better chance of winning one of these cash prizes. If we should win, this money would go directly into our building fund. First prize at the June Convention will be a check for \$3,500. There are numerous other prizes scaling down to the minimum of \$100. We havenq won anything yet, and we will have no chance of winning if we donq reach our goals. If you are unable to renew for whatever reason, or you are discouraged by what we are doing, contact me at 904-272-1619 and letqs talk about it. This is not just about money, this is about the number of members we have. We have a full time team of members who talk to Congress about veterans and their needs. The American Legion, with 2.4 million members, is the largest and strongest voice that Congress hears from about veteransqissues. Right from the front, we were the first veteran organization to let Congress know about the VA problem. Remember,

we are the only veteran organization that has an office in the Capitol Building and in the Pentagon.

If you have not renewed your membership for 2015, please do so asap, and let me explain what happens to your \$35.00 yearly dues. \$21.00 immediately goes out to the Department of Florida and National headquarters. We operate on the remaining \$14.00. The \$14.00 covers our monthly rental of the Lions Club, the publishing of our bi-monthly newsletter, postage, paper, ink, and other supplies. In addition, we make donations to Children and Youth programs, school medals, ROTC, etc. At our monthly meetings, a complete finance report is given. No one in this Post is receiving any type of pay. We are all volunteers. In fact, some of our officers and members have reached into their own wallets to help vets in the local area.

# FUND RAISERS

We have been utilizing 3 types of fund raisers to raise money so that when the right situation arises, we will be able to move into our own Post home. We operate our Post on the Dues & Reserves money. Any money that is raised for the purpose of the Building Fund, goes into that Fund and will not be used for any other purpose. We do a monthly 50-50, with half of the proceeds going into the Building Fund. We issue Promissory Notes in the amount of \$50.00

and up. This money also goes directly into the Building Fund. We also raffled off a hunting rifle, with all proceeds going into the Building Fund. Our members had voted, and it is in our minutes and records, that the Building Fund can be used only for the purpose of moving our Post into a Post home. We will be doing a new weapon raffle starting at our October meeting. As for the Promissory Notes . it is a simple program. We issue a legal Promissory Note in the amount \$50.00 or more, and for the first 2 years, the Post pays no interest on these funds. At the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, we will pay interest of 2% higher than what VyStar pays on their savings account. No one knows who is participating in this program or the amount, only the Finance Officer, the Post Commander, and the member who is issued the Note has this information. The member who has the Note can cash it in at any time for any reason whatsoever. Again, this is a private matter. At our monthly meeting, we do disclose a full financial report. If you cannot come to a meeting, and you would like to know how we are doing financially, please call me at 904-272-1619.
