## **COMMANDER'S CORNER**

We are 2 months into our membership drive for 2016 membership year. We have 157 members who have already paid their 2016 dues which puts us 7 cards ahead of last year at the same time. However, with Department of Florida has raised our quota of members approximate 8%. We are only at 42% this year compared to last year at 50%. When we took over this Post 7-1/2 years ago, we had 67 members, of which 8 to 12 members would come to our monthly meeting. We now have 380 members, and we are continuing to grow. We now have a minimum of 30 members attending, with a maximum of 50+. It shows that our Post is growing in the right direction. Our last few meetings have been exceptional, with the majority of those attending speaking up and offering some very good suggestions. I want each and every one of you to know that as long as I am around, every member has an equal voice. Post members run our Post, not the Commander or Executive Board. At our meetings, we usually have a guest speaker come in talking about every day issues that affect all of us.

Over the years, several of our members have brought in friends, relatives, etc., and after attending one or two meetings, they joined our Post. Our dues have stayed the same since 2009. We operate solely on the portion of the dues that our Post gets to keep. To be clear, of our \$35.00 dues, we keep \$14.00. The other \$21.00 goes on to state and national. As of January 1, 2016, we will be sending \$29.00 to state and national. That is why our dues will be \$45.00 per year starting on January 1, 2016. Through our Post fund raisers, we are slowly raising cash to secure our own building. But this takes time. We have a good deal with the Lions Club to rent the hall on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of every month. During our first years, we rented a room at the Rodeway Inn, which was nowhere as nice as where we meet now - well lit parking, handicap accessible building, with a nice kitchen, and very nice restrooms. During those first 4-5 years, a few of our individual members and I paid for the meeting room out of our own pockets. We also had collections to help needy vet families. Now with our increased membership, it is very seldom that we have to reach into our own pockets to pay for our bills.

Believe it or not, sending out our Post newsletter every other month costs us a little over \$250.00 per mailing. Yes, we send approximately half of these letters out by email, otherwise our cost would be doubled. However, we must continue the newsletter due to the fact a majority of our members do not attend our meetings and would not have a clue as to what we are doing. For instance, last year with our Legion, Auxiliary, and SAL all reaching the 100% membership goal and by participating in over a dozen Legion programs and providing financial assistance to veteran families in this area, we won the National Commanders Post Excellence Award. Our Post officers meet with the County Commissioners, County Manager, County VSO, and others, and also meet with Congressman Ted Yoho and his staff, and now we are meeting the Orange Park Mayor and his staff. We talk on veterans issues and how we can work together. The reason for this column is to let you know just where your yearly dues are being used. No one is getting a dime for themselves. Its all about %ETS HELPING VETS,+ their families, and the local community.


